

Blazon Bahá'u'lláh's Name: Mystery in Tihrán



Blazon: To proclaim widely. Telling others about Bahá'u'lláh through our words and actions.

Emblazon: To read Bahá'u'lláh's words and prayers in order to remember Him.

The Báb told His followers to travel and share His Teachings. He promised Mullá Husayn that a holy Mystery awaited him. In Tihrán, Mullá Husayn sent the Báb's Writings to a Man Who was known for His kindness. That Man later became known as Bahá'u'lláh. He was the Mystery that the Báb had promised.

When Bahá'u'lláh read the Báb's Writings, He said that the "soul-stirring words" had the same

power as the Qur'án, the Holy Book of Islam. To show His appreciation to Mullá Husayn, Bahá'u'lláh sent him gifts that were rare in Iran at that time.

Bahá'u'lláh and the Báb wrote to each other, but They never met in person. The Báb's Mission was to prepare people to accept Bahá'u'lláh as a Messenger of God. But it was not time for Bahá'u'lláh to announce His own Station. Instead, He shared the Báb's Message with others.
