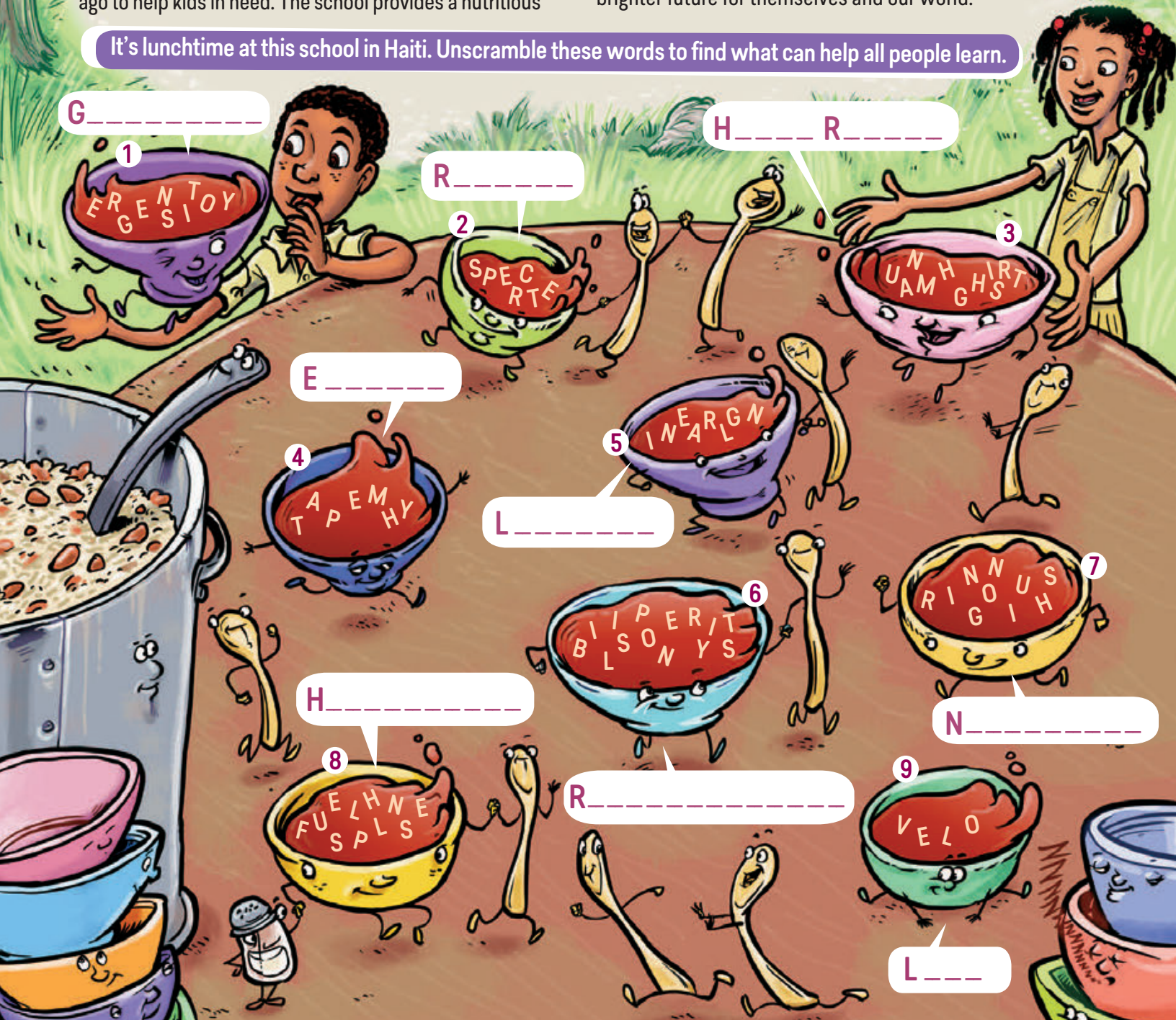
Have you ever tried to do homework when you’re really hungry? It’s almost impossible to focus. Sadly, that’s the reality for millions of kids.
