THIS IS A ZERO WASTE, ECO-FRIENDLY VESSEL.

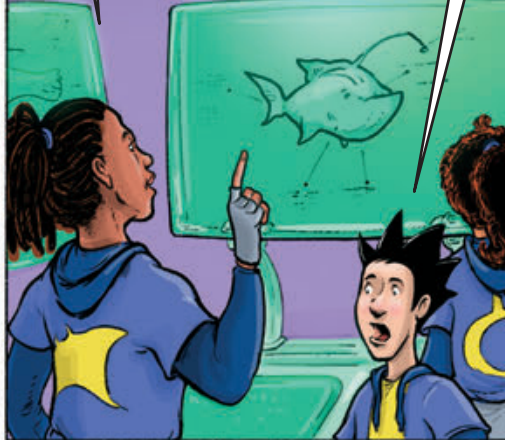
WE STUDY SEAWATER AND TRACK OCEAN TEMPERATURES AND CURRENTS.

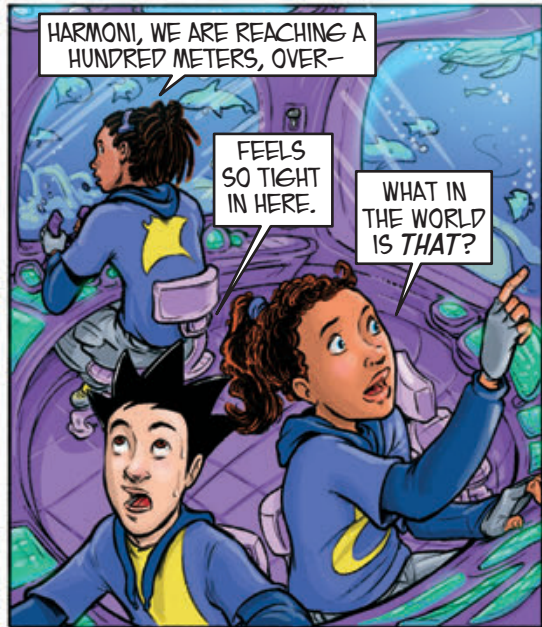
